DEGREE LEVEL PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS

Degree candidates are eligible to sit for professional examinations after training in accredited institutions and undergoing a one year internship program supervised by KNDI. There are six areas of internship which then guides sitting an examination in any of those areas. A degree candidate shall sit for two papers (paper 1 and paper 2) as per the area of internship as follows;

1. Clinical Nutrition Professional Examination

Paper 1; General Paper in Nutrition and Dietetics

This paper shall comprise of the general concepts in nutrition and dietetics covered during training and applied in the internship practicum.

The examinable areas for this professional examination include;

- 1. Human anatomy
- 2. Human physiology
- 3. Macronutrients
- 4. Micronutrients
- 5. First aid
- 6. Leadership in nutrition and dietetics
- 7. Nutrition in disease management

Paper 2; Specialized Paper

This paper shall comprise of core areas in clinical nutrition.

The examinable areas for this professional examination include;

- 1. Biochemistry
- 2. Nutrition assessment
- 3. Nutrition education and counselling
- 4. Food microbiology and parasitology
