DIPLOMA LEVEL PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

A diploma level student is eligible to sit for professional examinations after training and graduation in accredited institutions by KNDI. A diploma student shall sit for two papers (paper 1 and paper 2) as follows;

2. <u>Nutrition Technologist Professional Examination</u>

Paper 1; General Paper in Nutrition and Dietetics

This paper shall comprise of core areas in nutrition and dietetics taught at diploma level. The examinable areas for this professional examination include;

- 5. Principles of food processing and preservation
- 6. Food safety and hygiene
- 7. Nutrition education and counselling

- 9. Introduction to nutrition and dietetics
- 10. Principles of human nutrition
- 11. Introduction to biostatistics
- 12. Human anatomy and physiology
- 13. Nutrition in the lifespan
- 14. Nutrition assessment and surveillance
- 15. Legal aspects in nutrition and dietetics
- 16. Maternal and child nutrition

Paper 2; Specialized Paper

This paper shall comprise of core areas in nutrition taught at diploma level. The examinable areas for this professional examination include;

- 1. Nutrition anthropology
- 2. Communicable and non-communicable disease
- 3. Food security
- 4. Community partnership skills
- 5. Nutrition Intervention in HIV
- 6. Introduction to nutrition epidemiology
