KNDI CIRCULAR

RE: ORAL EXAMINATION FOR INTERNSHIP EXEMPTIONS

KNDI would like to inform all graduates of nutrition and dietetics that acquired their Bachelor degree from 1st January to 31st December 2014 and have not gone through internship to urgently apply for oral examinations scheduled to take place between 9th - 13th **October 2017**. By this notice, all 2014 graduates who are in this category are therefore exempted from internship. This also applies for all diploma upgrades with permanent employment.

Eligibility Criteria

The criteria for oral examinations are as follows:

- i. Candidates must be indexed
- ii. Candidates must apply for oral examination
- iii. Diploma upgrades must present appointment letters from their employer

Take note that after the oral examinations, candidates who will be successful shall proceed to take written professional examinations on 9th **November 2017** and shall qualify for licensure upon satisfying KNDI Examinations Board and the Council.
