RE: **NOTICE ON STUDENT INDEXING PURSUING NUTRITION AND DIETETICS**

Kenya Nutritionists and Dieticians Institute (KNDI) refers to Cap 253B section 13(q) which requires students pursuing BSc, Diploma and Certificate in Nutrition and Dietetics to be indexed. Be advised that you are supposed to index within 1-month after admission.

You are therefore informed as follows; -

- i. All students who are yet to index or have attempted to index are required to do so by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2026 to avoid penalties.
- ii. Only students who shall have completed indexing and have KNDI index numbers shall be allowed to proceed for clinical attachment, concentrated practicum and community attachment.
- iii. All attachments, (clinical and community) and concentrated practicum shall be monitored through attachment monitoring system software as per the attached circular to vice chancellor, principals and CEOs of training institutions.
- iv. All students who proceed for clinical attachment and practicum shall wear scrubs (Luxury purple-code 743089) and a KNDI badge bearing index number and name of the student. The badge shall attract KES.750 paid to KNDI.



Be advised accordingly.

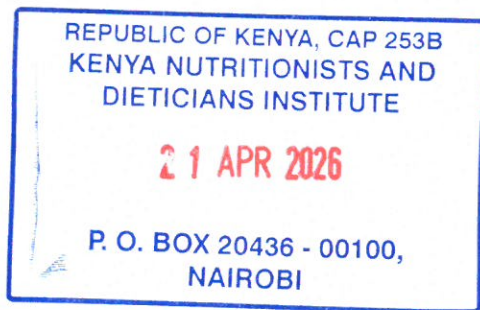

CONCENTRATED PRACTICUM LOGBOOK(CIRCULAR)**

KNDI recently trained all HODs of universities and TVET Colleges including KMTCs on attachment Management system which include common logbook. We want to thank you for quick response to release them.

Please take note that, with immediate effect from the date of this letter, all Nutrition and Dietetics students pursuing degree, diploma and certificate courses will strictly use the common logbook hosted by KNDI throughout their attachment and concentrated practicum period. No students will be allowed to undertake KNDI professional exams without records from the attachment logbook. This logbook replaces the other logbook previously used internally by your institution.

Note:

- 1) KNDI shall be remotely monitoring this system for all students. All students should ensure they index to be logged into the system.
- 2) This shall apply for clinical and community placements in a government hospital with a Kenya Master Health Facility code.
- 3) Food science Interface will follow soon.
