**RE-REGISTRATION AND REVOCATION OF THE PRACTICE
LICENSE**

The Disciplinary Committee of KNDI at a meeting held on 17th August 2020 took note of your letter dated 3rd August 2020 (channeled through an email address micoushkod@gmail.com) in response to a letter from the Chairman of the KNDI's Disciplinary Committee of the same date inviting you to appear before the said Committee to show cause why disciplinary action should not be taken against you. In your response, you categorically stated that you would NOT appear before the Committee.

In your absence the Committee proceeded with the meeting, considered your said response and all other documents tabled before it and noted the following:

- 1) In your response you were extremely arrogant, defiant, abusive and dismissive.
- 2) You have consistently displayed a hostile stand towards, the KNDI Council, the office of the CEO in your many communications.
- 3) You have for some time now, persistently engaged in activities, propaganda and correspondence which are harmful to the reputation and operations of KNDI. You have challenged the legitimacy of the Council which has been duly appointed under Cap 253B of the laws of Kenya, the legitimacy of the position of the CEO, the duly authorized operations and activities of KNDI and now the legitimacy of the Disciplinary Committee.
- 4) You have associated yourself with a group which has openly declared that it is Anti KNDI and whose activities are meant to bring down KNDI as an Institution duly established by an Act of Parliament.

- 5) You dared the CEO to deregister you by 30th July, 2020 but went on to state that with or without a practicing certificate, you will continue to practice in contravention of the KNDI Act.

The Committee found that in light of the above you are guilty of gross-misconduct and consequently resolved to remove your name from the KNDI register pursuant to the provisions of Section 26, Paragraph (1)(c) of Cap 253B with effect from 17th August, 2020.

You are therefore henceforth not allowed to practice as a Nutritionist and Dietician in the Republic of Kenya under the professional licence Reference Number **G/2298/17** issued to you by KNDI and by extension Private Practice license No. KNDI/REG/PP13/20 for Middle Health Solution (**BN/9PCQVKZ**).

You are hereby given 14 days from the date of this letter to surrender your original registration certificate and Private practice licence to KNDI Headquarters failure to which Section 26(4) of Cap 253B shall apply.

Take note that any further practice in Nutrition and Dietetics in Kenya shall be treated as an offense under all applicable and relevant laws of the land.

Be advised accordingly.
