Referring to Sections 19(5) the Nutritionists Act, 18, 2007 KNDI hereby give a notice to all professionals who are non-compliant with the provisions of the law as follows:

- Clear outstanding balances by within 30 days ending on 16/6/2019 at 5pm accompanied by duly filled new registration form (RC2- Ref: KNDI/INDIVIDUAL/LICENSE /FORM/002) with attachment of certified academic and national documents as follows:
  - i. University/college certificates and academic transcripts (certified by registrars of University/college),
  - ii. KCSE certificate (certified by MOE-Quality Assurance Section)
  - iii. National identity card (certified by lawyer or a chief).
- 2. Full details of current employer, County of operation, physical address, current mobile telephone number and email.
- 3. Failure to comply within the set timelines, will result in the following:
  - i. Immediate removal from the master register of professionals.
  - ii. Appropriate legal action in accordance with Section 33 and 36(1).
- 4. Take note that late submissions shall attract a penalty of Ksh. 200 per day up to a maximum of 30 days. Be advised accordingly.
  - 5. All payments should be made through M-PESA PayBill no. 272223 with account details: Registration Number followed by the word "Compliant" e.g. G/00367/: Compliant.
