THE NUTRITIONISTS AND DIETICIANS ACT

(No. 18 of 2007)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 38(g) of the Nutritionists and Dieticians Act, 2007 the Nutritionists and Dieticians Council, in consultation with the Cabinet Secretary for Health, makes the following Regulations—

THE NUTRITIONISTS AND DIETICIANS (TRAINING INSTITUTIONS) (FEES) REGULATIONS, 2019

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Nutritionists and Dieticians (Training Institutions) (Fees) Regulations, 2019. Citation.
2. The Fees payable for services rendered in the second column of the Schedule shall be as set out in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule. Fees.
