Objectives

- Provide a list of compliant members
- Provide user accounts for compliant members
- Provide a list of all candidates
- Provide a voting mechanism for stakeholders
- Provide an admin account for the presiding officer
- Provide tallying of all votes
- Provide SMS notifications for all necessary steps

Tools

- Bulk SMS system
- Bulk SMS API
- Acting Chairperson Voting system
- List of All Compliant Members

Bulk SMS System

DIGEN ENTERPRISES LIMITED will provide a portal for the voting process and a SENDER_ID called DIGENTEXT. This will be used to send SMSs to all compliant practitioners informing them of:

- A pending voting process
- Their Credentials for logging into the system
- The confirmation of a vote casted
- The Final results of the voting process



Use the official emails indicated on the left when giving reply through email. Hard copy mails should be Addressed strictly to the Chief Executive Officer. Mails addressed confidentially to the CEO should be marked confidential.

BULK SMS API

DIGEN ENTERPRISES LIMITED will provide a Secure API that will allow The Acting Chairperson Voting system to send personalized SMS to the complaint practitioners to inform them of:

- The confirmation of a vote casted
- The final results of the voting process

ACTING CHAIRPERSON VOTING SYSTEM

The ICT department of KNDI supported by KNDI staff will develop a system to carry out a free and fair online election process. The system will require three layers of confirmation from the compliant practitioner:

- Unique Code
- Registration Number
- National Identification Number

The system will have live results monitoring available to all compliant practitioners.

The system will also have a presiding officer account to check on the election process and to monitor the process.

LIST OF ALL COMPLIANT MEMBERS

The ICT and Registration departments of KNDI supported by KNDI staff will provide a List of all compliant practitioners to the Presiding officer. This is the only List to be used in the voting process.
