Instructions to Applicants in Readiness for the November 2025 Online Licensing Professional Examinations

All **APPROVED** applicants for the November 2025 Written Licensing Professional Examinations are expected to be able to log in to **KNDI USER ACCOUNT** for accessing updates on all examination's procedures. Anyone who **HAS NOT OPENED AN ACCOUNT SHALL NOT** be able to access and sit for the professional examinations.

The examinations at the various levels of profession are scheduled below;

Certificate level applicants shall sit for one paper

1. Nutrition and Dietetics Technician Professional Examinations

Diploma level applicants shall sit for two papers

1. Paper 1: General paper in nutrition and dietetics for both specialties (Dietetics or Nutrition)
2. Paper 2: Specialized as per the chosen area (Dietetics or Nutrition) for each applicant

Degree level applicants shall sit for two papers

1. Paper 1: General paper in nutrition and dietetics
2. Paper 2: Specialized as per the chosen area for internship/oral examination

Candidates are expected to answer ALL the questions within the 1 hour 45 minutes
Nutritionist/Dietician Professional Examination (Degree Level)	1. Degree level examination paper shall comprise of 50 questions 2. The examination shall run for 1 hour 45 minutes 3. Candidates are expected to take 2 minutes to answer each question 4. There will be NO MOVING BACK to a previously answered question 5. Candidates are expected to answer ALL the questions within the 1 hour 45 minutes

Note to all Applicants; Read the following instructions carefully

- Examinations shall be accessible in the accounts of applicants for 2 hours.
- The first 20 minutes shall be used for preparation.
A candidate shall be required to upload a **REAL TIME IMAGE** of him/her (self) within the first 20 minutes before commencement of the examination.

NB; REAL TIME IMAGE is defined as a photo (**jpeg format**) of the candidate **on the day of examination**.

Any photo taken or uploaded outside this period shall be rejected by the system.

In addition, on the day of examination a candidate is expected to position him/her (self);

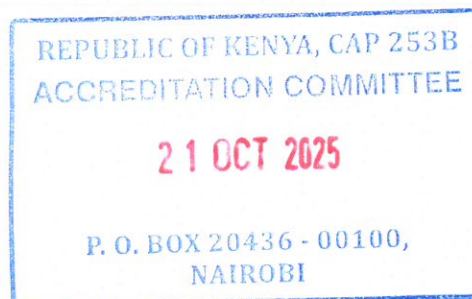
- Where there is **STABLE NETWORK CONNECTIVITY** to run for the entire examination period
 - In a **SILENT ENVIRONMENT** to sit for the examination
- A **SPECIFIC LINK** shall be **SENT TO THE APPLICANT'S ACCOUNT** and **EMAIL BEARING THE EXAMINATION PAPER TO BE DONE** on the material day.
 - Once the candidate has accessed the link to the examination in the account, the examination shall **START STRAIGHTAWAY AND RUN FOR THE 2 HOURS ALLOCATED**.
 - Take note that **THE LINK IS USER SPECIFIC (no sharing)**.
 - Candidates can use a computer or a smart phone to answer examination questions. For purposes of uploading real-time photos before the examination, **CANDIDATES SHOULD USE A LAPTOP OR A SMART PHONE WITH A GOOD WORKING CAMERA**.
 - A data bundle of 2GB is sufficient for the entire examination period.
 - Provisional results shall be real time as soon as the examination paper is completed within the provided time slot.
 - Consolidated results shall be channeled to the students within 10 working days
